
Yoga and Yogic Powers To Be Available Soon

Spring pilgrimage to Laxmanjhula

Swami Karunanand and Swami Hrishanand recently went on pilgrimage to Rishikesh, the sacred Ganges and Laxmanjhula. They have met several times with the management of Kailashananda Mis-

sion Trust and have clarified that KMT is planning to have a website to make their services such as Shradha, Navaratra, Paths and Pujas more easily available. However, KMT gave no time frame for having this website available and have recommended that in the mean time, each individual make their request via mail or fax as has been described previously. KMT also cautions that they are not vet prepared to accept orders for herbs, due to legal issues with exporting herbs out of India. The Swamis have been greatly inspired by their trip and urge everyone to go if they can. The Yogi Gupta Society is committed to helping Yogi Gupta's Mission both in India as well as here in the West and therefore would like to help KMT maintain its operations. She is survived by her worthy son, Kevin Burgdorf, of Melbourne, Florida, who was a wonderful caretaker for her last months. She is also survived by her brothers, Gary Gregory, also of Melbourne, and Larry Gregory of Evansville, and many nieces and nephews.

Saraswati Dayee was a cosmetologist by trade and a wonderful interior decorator by hobby, which made her home like a temple! Once Saraswati Davee commented to me about how she thought hairdressing and cosmetology was probably considered a rather lowly trade and one based on vanity. Shortly thereafter, Guruji gave a class in the Guru Yoga Course proclaiming that when Lord Krishna and his brother Bala Ram went to their guru for study they learned sixty four trades in sixty four days! One of them was cosmetology. We can well remember that Lord Krishna does appear in pictures with rather stylish hairdo's and earrings! Saraswati was very inspired by this and opened her own hair salon that offered all kinds of organic and non-chemical services to all for healthful and stylish appearance. She was the only one here in Brevard County, Florida with natural cosmetology!

She was (and is) a devoted disciple of Guruji for over twenty five years, having come to the Florida Ashram through Videha Kumari and Swami Gyananand. She served greatly for many years as Videha Kumari's assistant in the Ashram. She overcame many obstacles in her life, finally to be acclaimed by Guruji, "You are a great, great ascetic and a great disciple!"

She followed the 30-day and 20-day programs more strictly than any other disciple and did them back-to-back (fifty days)!

During the last class at his Midtown Manhattan apartment, it was apparent that it was to be the last class and the last time I would be at His physical feet. He left New York a day or so later and never returned to America. Guruji was coughing heavily that evening. He said: "The Guru is not sick." And this is of course because the Guru is not the body. Once in Nature Cure class he said: "Believe Yogi Gupta speaks the truth." He was very clear in many messages that last class, one of them being: "I love all my children very much." Guruji is our Father and Mother; the One and All; the pillar of strength and light who selflessly took us under His care. So although our beloved Guruji has entered Maha Samadhi and we can no longer see Him physically, He is still guiding us every day. As He said many times: "I am closer to you than your own breath."
